ABILITY TO CONDUCT TESTS and PROMOTE STUDENTS TO HIGHER RANKS

CCDPW instructors, above the age of 18 years old and starting at the rank of 1st class brown belt, can conduct tests and promote students up to 2 ranks below their current rank.

For example:

1st class brown belt instructor can test and promote students up to 3rd class brown

1st grade black belt instructor can test and promote students up to 2nd class brown

2nd grade black belt instructor can test and promote students up to 1st class brown

3rd grade black belt instructor can test and promote students up to 1st grade black

4th grade black belt instructor can test and promote students up to 2nd grade black

5th grade black belt senior instructor can test and promote students up to 3rd grade black

Adult 3rd and 2nd class brown belts, and junior age (below 18 years of age) brown/black belts cannot test and promote students to higher ranks.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR PROMOTION

1. All promotions up to and including 5th grade black require a successful test of basic curriculum requirements as shown in the official CCDPW syllabus.

CCDPW recognizes some instructors have their own requirements in addition to the CCDPW basic syllabus. To qualify for promotion, the candidate must be proficient in demonstrating and explaining CCDPW curriculum requirements of the rank and instructor's additional curriculum, if any.

2. The candidate meets CCDPW's minimum recommended time between rank promotions. (See official CCDPW Guidelines for "Minimum Time Between Rank")
3. The candidate has been a student of the instructor for at least 1 year. Instructors will not promote students that have been with them for less than 1 year. Instructors agree to only promote their own students.
4. The candidate is an active member of CCDPW if receiving a CCDPW certificate.
